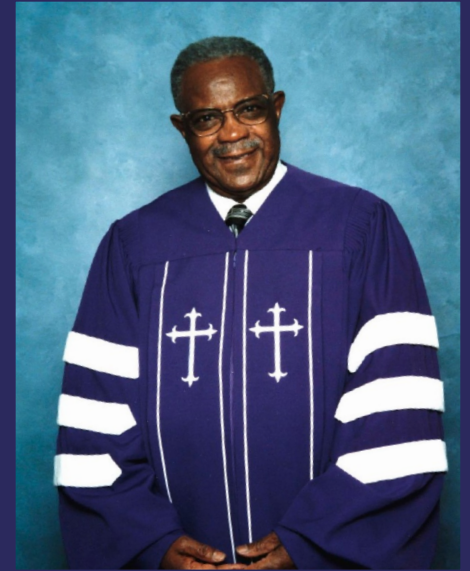

Vision and Purpose

The Rev. Dr. Ambrose M. Perry scholarship encourages the educational growth of the children and youth that are members of the Neabsco Baptist Church for at least one (1) year. The Committee will recognize the academic achievements, awards, special merits and other special recognition that our youth accomplish in as they advance their educational experiences and community service.

Scholarship Mission

The mission of the Rev. Dr. Ambrose M. Perry Education Fund is to recognize the youth of the Neabsco Baptist Church who are graduating from high school and to provide financial assistance to the youth who are desirous of attending an academic institution of higher education through yearly scholarships. Additionally, the Committee will recognize members who will represent the Church as an Ambassador for Jesus Christ by demonstrating their Christian values in the community at large.

History and Background

The Neabsco Baptist Church education and scholarship fund was created by its former Pastor, the late Rev Dr Ambrose M. Perry in 1986.

He established a self-perpetuating education fund for the youth and earmarked annually by the Neabsco Baptist Church Board of Directors. On June 26, 2010, the Scholarship was renamed as the Rev. Dr. Ambrose M. Perry Education Fund.

Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

High School Graduates & Continuing Undergraduate Applicants Must:

- Complete the Scholarship applications which will be available the first Sunday in March each year.
- Submit the application with supporting documentation to the Committee Chairperson by the first Sunday in June each year.
- The Scholarship funds will be distributed no later than the first Sunday in August of each year.
- Late applications will not be considered after the deadline unless circumstances exist beyond the applicant's control and is dependent upon funds availability.
- Consistently demonstrate Christian values at home, school, church, and the community at large
- Be an active member of Neabsco Baptist Church for one year and in good standing
- Serve in one of the church ministries for a minimum of six months i.e., Youth Choir, Youth Ministry, Vacation Bible School, Usher's Ministry, Young Adult Ministry, Women of the Word, Men Fellowship
- Provide a letter of recommendation from a teacher, school counselor, or church leader
- Submit proof of acceptance/attendance to an accredited 2 or 4 year college or university – late receipt of acceptance letters may be considered
- Enroll as a full-time student (minimum 12 semester hours)

- Submit a 250-300 word essay on one of the subjects listed in the application
- Participate in at least one community service outreach mission
- Meet all of the required criteria and the deadline application for the education awards
- Not exceed 24 years of age for scholarship recipient
- Scholarship will only be distributed for the number of years for the program enrolled
- Continuing undergraduate applicants must have a satisfactory academic record for a 2.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale. (If GPA is less than 2.0, please explain.) The applicant should include the appropriate information to support the GPA requirement
